<p>Ina MACAIONE is an architect as an associate professor at the University of Basilicata, Department of the “Culture Europee e del Mediterraneo: Archiettura, Ambiente, Patrimoni Culturali”. She works with several universities and research centers. In the Local Administration of Matera, she was Executive Councillor for Land and Construction, for the Protection and Restoration of Landscape, Urban quality, Architecture and Housing Politics and for the Protection of UNESCO Heritage (Sassi and Murgia materana) and the historic city centre. In a sustainable development perspective, her specific research subjects are: the relationship between reading built environment and its re-generation through the architecture project; old city restoration in relation to nature, especially starting from the idea of nature-city’s parks; the connection of architecture to archaeological, landscape and eco-construction areas; the enhancement of the city as an integrated complex of cultural and environmental heritage within urbsturism idea and offer, meant as knowledge and narrativity of the above mentioned heritage. In these thematic fields she made several contributions, among which we find nature and civilization nature and civilization the books <i>Nature City.
